Hallandale Beach Police Officers and their supporters will hold a protest rally on Tuesday, June 16th at 10:00 a.m. in front of the Hallandale Beach City Hall to demand action by the City Manager on their concerns or his resignation for failing to support law enforcement in the city.

“The police are undermanned and under siege in Hallandale Beach,” said Broward County PBA President Patrick Hanrahan. “We hold the City Manager failing to hire enough officers and for neglecting the ones we have.”

The PBA will unveil a public information campaign reaching out to Hallandale City residents to contact their elected officials on behalf of the police.

Representatives of the Florida and Broward County Police Benevolent Associations will be in attendance.
