BROWARD COUNTY PBA URGES APPOINTMENT OF LAMBERTI AS INTERIM SHERIFF

Ft. Lauderdale – The Broward County Police Benevolent Association is urging Governor Charlie Crist to appoint acting Broward County Sheriff Al Lamberti as interim Sheriff.

In a letter to the governor, PBA president Dick Brickman praised Lamberti for giving the agency a much needed morale boost. “Lamberti has reenergized the entire agency. I have never seen one person make such a difference in such a short time,” he said. “I strongly urge you to consider him for Sheriff of Broward County.”

The PBA is impressed with Lamberti’s high level of professionalism and enthusiasm as well as his law enforcement experience; he has served at BSO for 29 years, including Chief of Police for the cities of Deerfield Beach, Hollywood and North Lauderdale.
